Another Rehab Success Story



PATIENT PROFILE:

- 72 year old male, hospitalized for 5 days.
- Resident at ERCC for 32 days.
- Diagnosed with Pubic Rami Fracture
- Was independent with activities of daily living prior to health complications that led to the fracture.

Mr. H was referred to ERCC for rehabilitation following a fall at home in which he sustained a pubic rami fracture. Prior to the fall, he had been hospitalized secondary shingles and other health complications. He presented with severe pain, weakness and decreased activity tolerance.

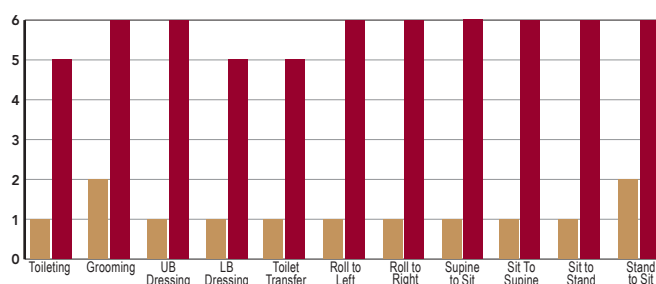
Mr. H was evaluated by Physical Therapy (PT) and Occupational Therapy (OT) at ERCC. His treatment focused gait training, upper and lower extremity strengthening, activities of daily living, and adaptive equipment.

RESULTS:

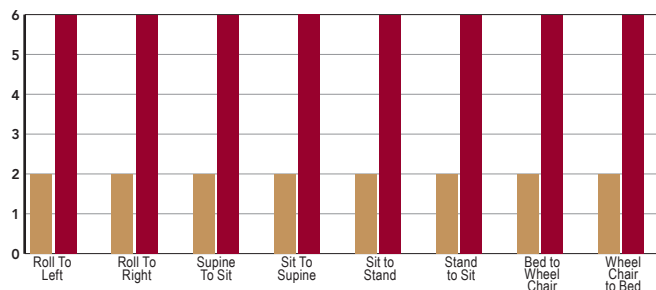
After undergoing treatment at ERCC, Mr. H was able to walk with a walker, dress, bathe, and toilet with minimum assistance. He returned home with home health therapy.
