



PATIENT PROFILE

- 74 year old male, hospitalized for 5 days.
- Resident at ERCC for 17 days.
- Diagnosed with Diabetes Swallowing Difficulties (Dysphagia,) and Muscle Weakness.
- Lived independently with family prior to hospitalization.

Mr. M came to ERCC to remediate dysfunction, following a hospital stay secondary to Oropharyngeal Dysphagia, with resulting poor intake and dehydration.

Mr. M was evaluated by Physical Therapy (PT) and Occupational Therapy (OT) at ERCC. His treatment focused on increasing his independence and efficiency with participation in self-care and mobility, in order for him to return to his prior level of function.



Outcome: After undergoing treatment at ERCC, Mr. M was able to return home with family support. He was independent with transfers, but needed someone nearby for safety while performing self-care and ambulating with a front wheeled walker. Mr. M needed minimal help to go up and down stairs.
