



PATIENT PROFILE

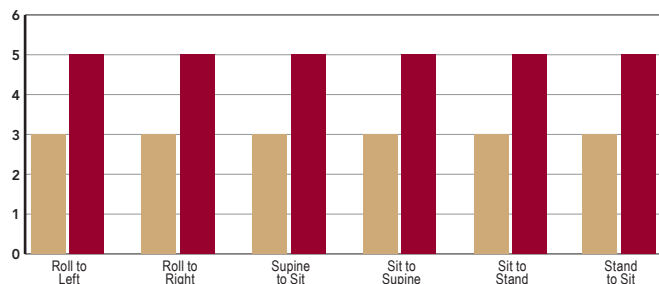
- 73 year old female, hospitalized for 7 days.
- Diagnosed with Muscle Weakness, Difficulty Walking, and Multiple Fractures (Ankle and Arm) following a fall.
- Lived independently at home with husband prior to injuries.

Mrs. S came to ERCC after suffering multiple fractures during a fall at home. Upon arrival, she was restricted to non-weight bearing status on her left upper and lower extremities and showed a marked decline in functional mobility, upper and lower extremity function, and activities of daily living (ADLs).

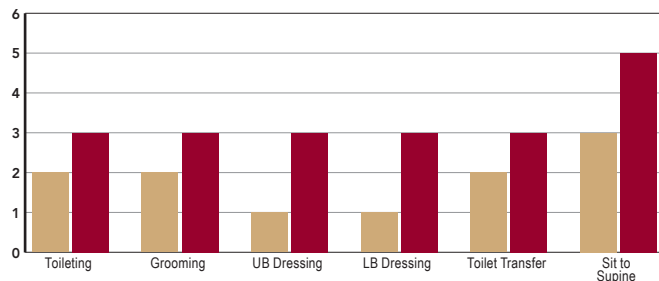
Mrs. S was evaluated by Physical Therapy (PT) and Occupational Therapy (OT) at ERCC. Her treatment focused on returning her to her prior level of independent functioning.
