



## PATIENT PROFILE


- 69 year old female, hospitalized for 3 days.
- Resident at ERCC for 14 days.
- Diagnosed with Right Total Knee Arthroplasty
- Lived independently at home prior to surgery.

Mrs. C lived with her family at home. She was highly active; independent with self-care, homemaking, and driving. She even cared for her disabled spouse prior to her surgery. Due to increasing pain and limited mobility in her right knee, she elected to undergo a total knee replacement.


Mrs. C was evaluated by Physical Therapy (PT) and Occupational Therapy (OT) at ERCC. Her treatment focused on increasing strength throughout both legs and arms, walking with use of a front wheeled walker, transfer training, and instruction regarding increasing independence with activities of daily living (ADLs).
