

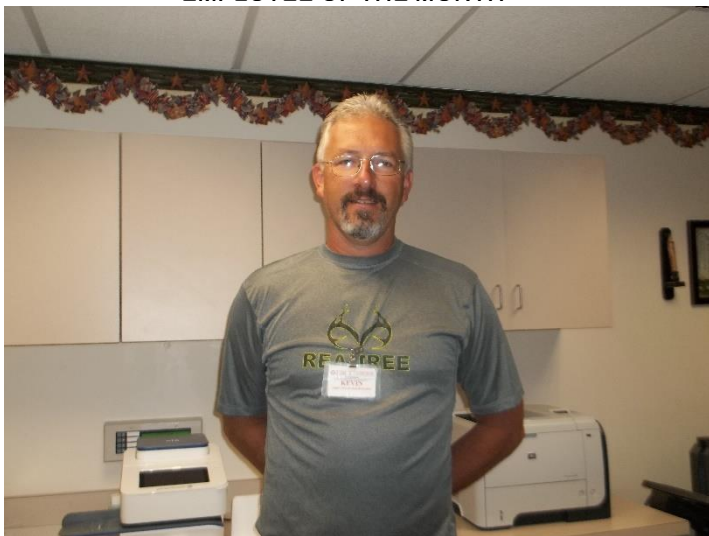

**Kevin Blosser, Director of Maintenance/Safety Dept.**

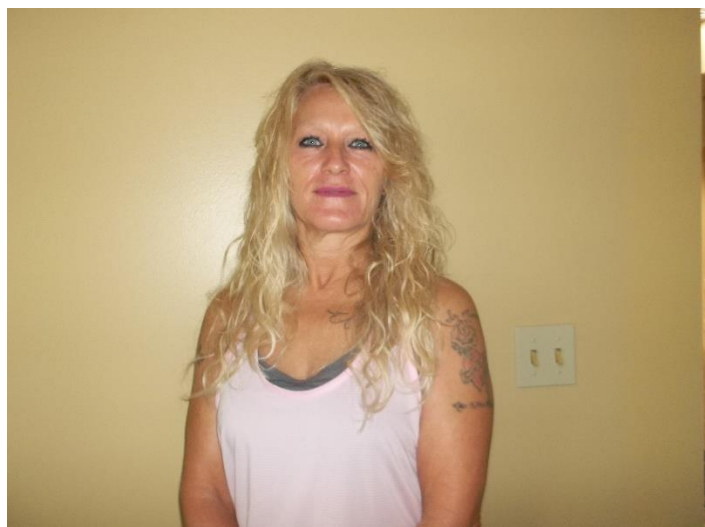

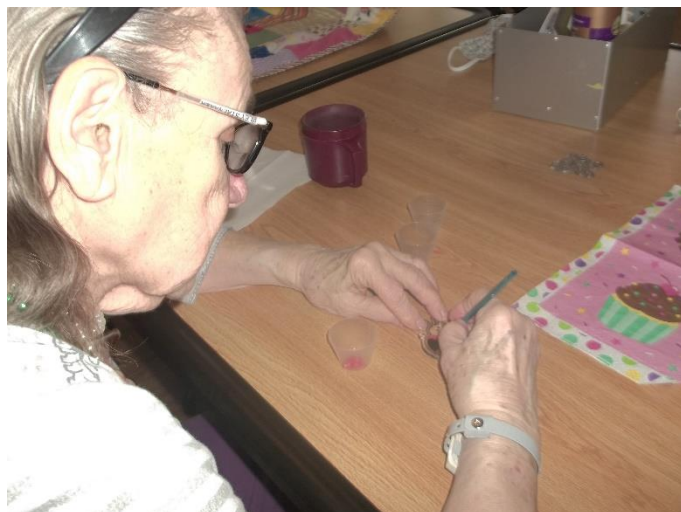
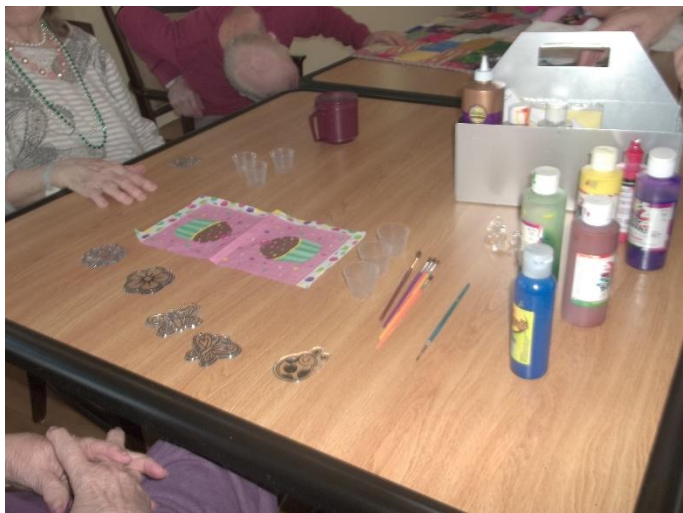
## RESIDENTS WINDOW VISITS

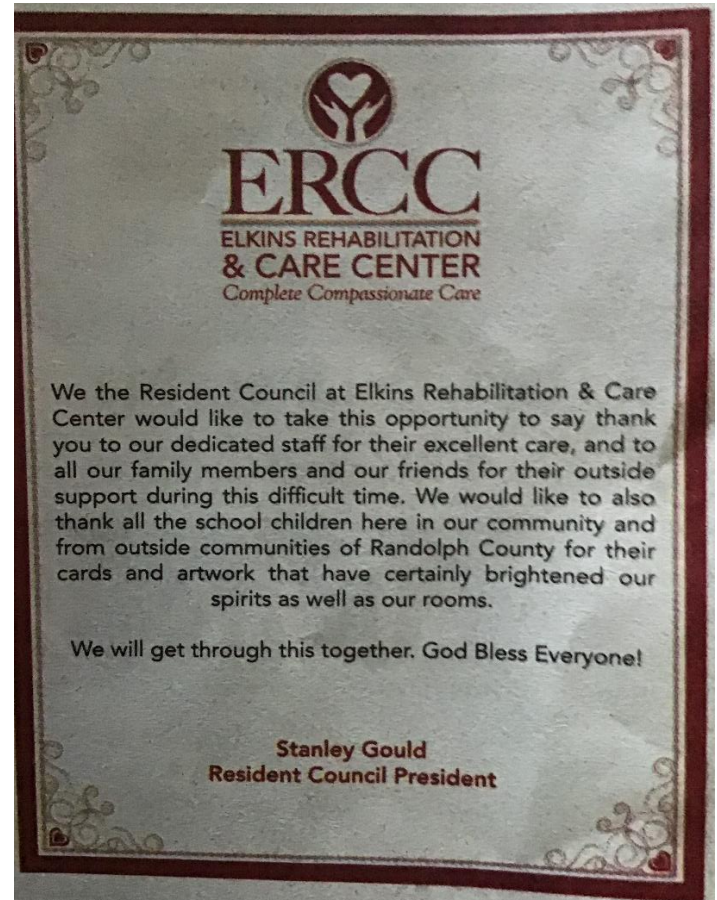
