
The Last week of April, Old Brick did animal theme. On Friday, April 30, they were dresses as monkeys. We love it when Old Brick makes their visits!



#### HAPPY RETIREMENT TO JULIA PHILLIPS, HIMA

She started at ERCC as what was then known as Ward Clerk. working on the "Blue" side, (now known as Woodland Village) in 1992. She is currently sharing the second highest seniority rank in the entire building. After the position of Ward Clerk she transferred to (then known as) Data Entry position. Afterwards she applied and received the position of Health Information Management Assistant. Her duties have grown and increased with the changing of the census activity in the facility. She does coding, abstracts diagnosis from medical records documentaion, assigns (International Classification Diseases) ICD-10 codes used for disease classification which in turn is used for billing and MDS. She also releases information for medical record requests, audits medical records for completeness and accuracy in order to intercept errors or incomplete documentation before auditors/surveyors look at them or before records are supoenaed for court. Her supervisor, Terri Brake, RHIT/HIM Director has worked with Julia for the past twenty-two years and considers her as her "work wife". She states " the HIM department has went through lots of changes. In the beginning, Julia was solo in doing the records, but due to many changes in the health care field, the work load has significantly increased and expanded. HIM is not just medical records anymore. With the changes and addition to the facility, the HIM Department has increased as well. Julia has never been late for work and very rarely called off sick in the years I have been her supervisor. She also worked at the Cheat River Lodge which means she worked basically seven days a week for eight years".

After Julia retires, she plans on enjoying her grandchildren and great grand children, crocheting, and woking in her flower garden. She is the proud grandmother and greatgrandmother of one; with one great grandchild on the way.
