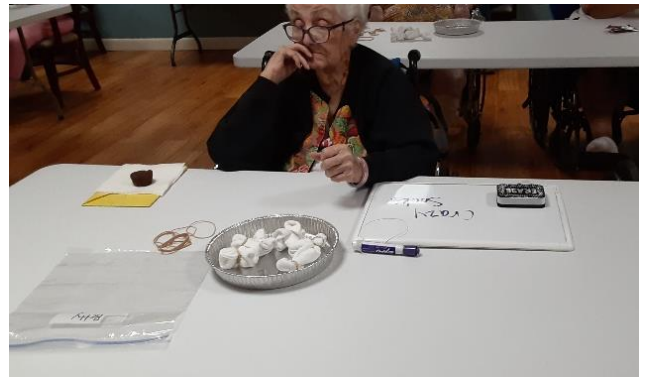




Visits from Old Brick
