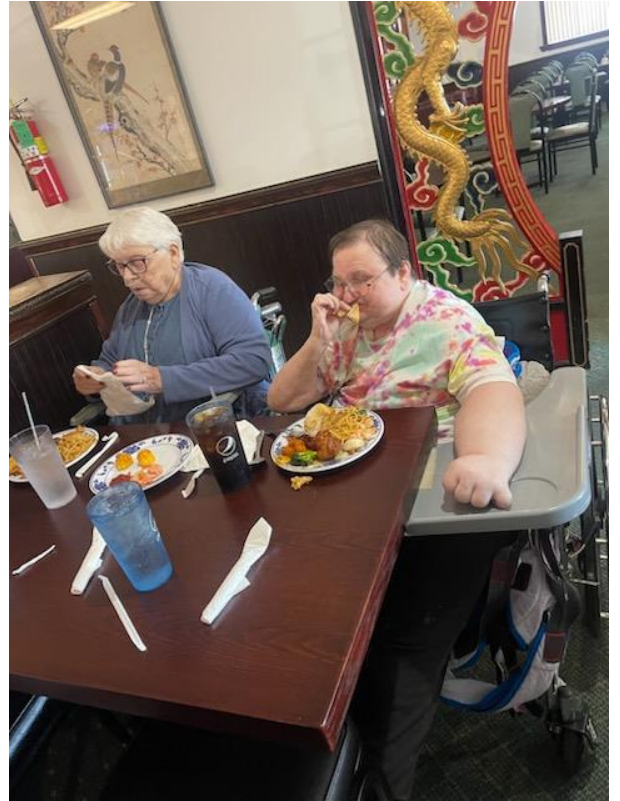

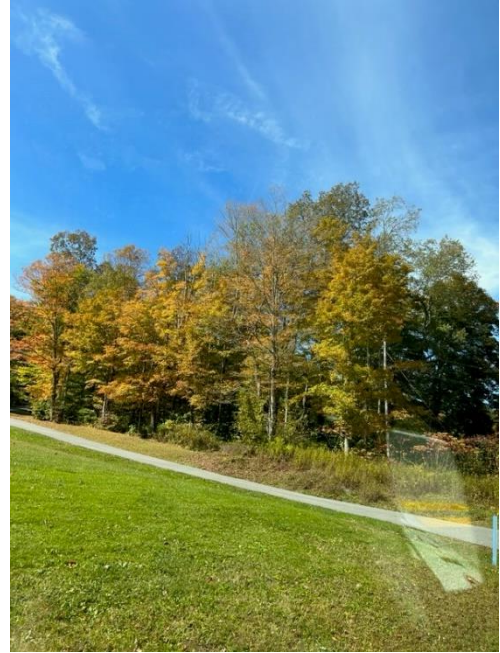
GRAND FEATURE PARADE OCT 7

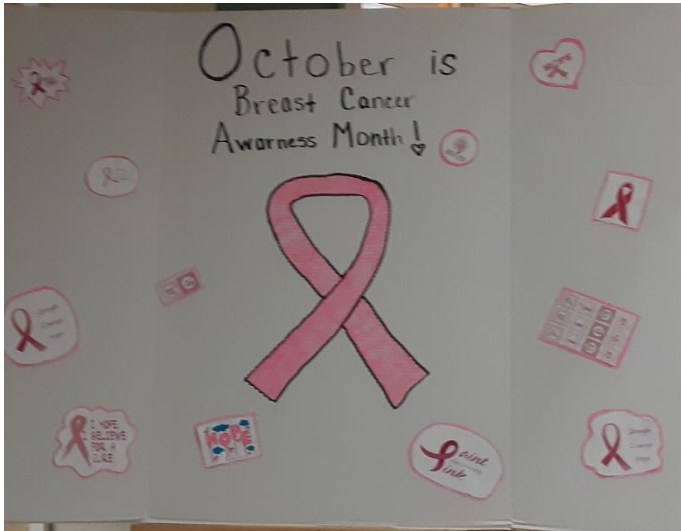


The activity staff took some residents out to see the colored leaves on October 11 and they enjoyed some ice cream/milk shake as well.

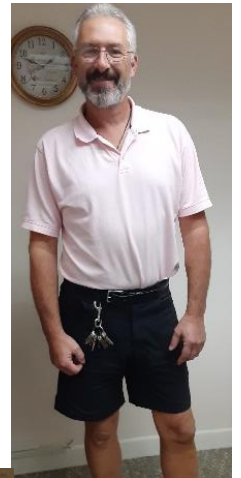

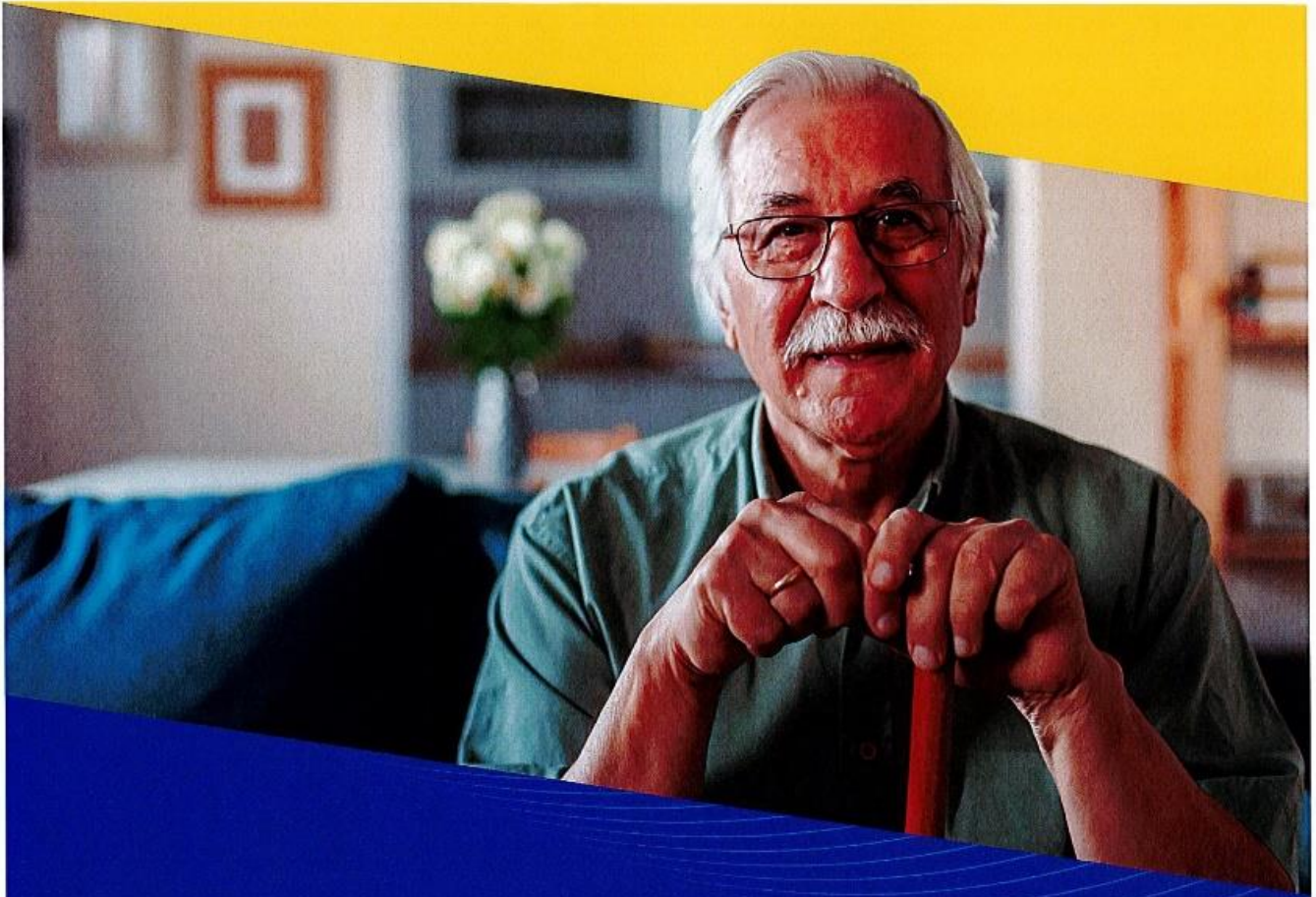
