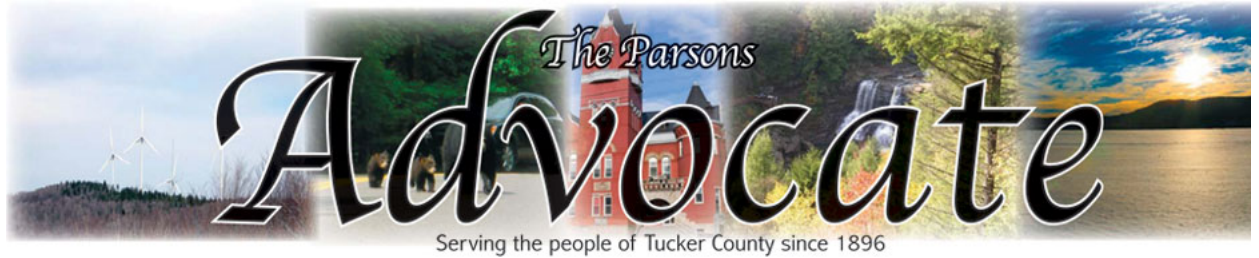

He is also an Ecumenical Delegate for the Diocese of Wheeling-Charleston. This position includes service with the West Virginia Council of Churches.
