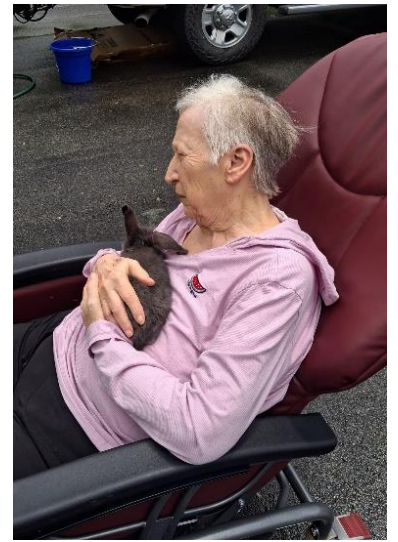
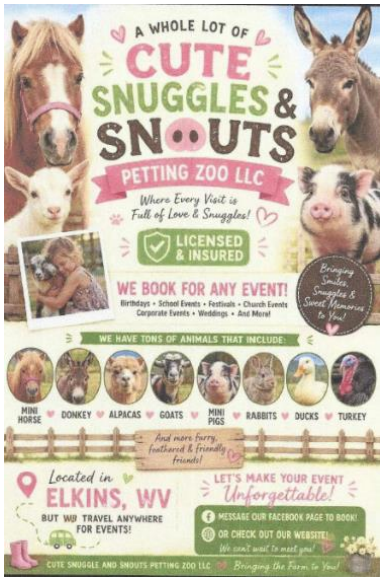




Old Brick comes through again! The residents really enjoyed this craft!

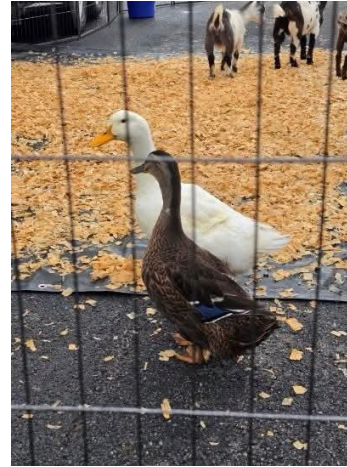
Sour dough ornaments with old brick 6-30-2026

They bring the “farm” to you! They have more furry and friendly friends.



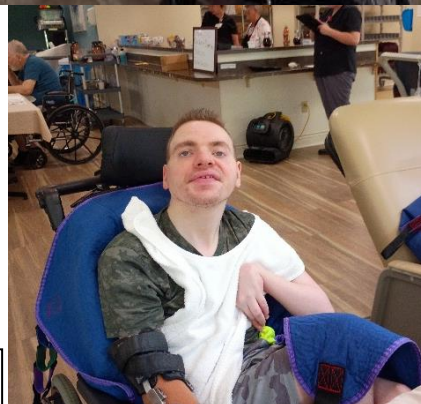


What is better than a Mexican luncheon when it is a rainy, dreary day? Nothing! So.... we decided this would be a great day to have Mexican food for lunch!
